

# 100% Healed 100% Manifested

Are you struggling to receive your healing? Do you hesitate to pray for the sick? Do you ever wonder why you don't see more people healed (including yourself)? Is healing a common occurrence in your ministry?

As a minister I did not enjoy praying for the sick, and the results were not very consistent even though I knew healing was the will of God. This has all changed since the Lord opened my eyes to some simple truths that I had not seen in the scriptures before. In this practical manual I will explain the progression of healing and ways you can speed the manifestation. It is my prayer that you will gain understanding, get more results, pray for the sick with renewed confidence and expectation, and see more people made well!

#### God Wants You Healed.

- Healing is the will of God.
  - Healing is the will of God for You.
  - It is hard to receive something unless you first know that it is intended for you.
  - So you must understand that the promise of healing has already been provided to you, by Jesus.
  - It is up to you now to <u>believe</u> and to <u>receive</u> what is already yours.

Example: If I give you my car then it's yours. You would not try to get it or ask me for what is already in your possession.

◆ **Psalm 103:1-5**, Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who **healeth all thy diseases**; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

All scriptures are from the King James Version unless otherwise noted.

- ◆ 3 John 1:2, Beloved, I wish <u>above all things</u> that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.
- ◆ **Hosea 11:3**, I taught Ephraim also to go, taking them by their arms; but they knew not that I healed them.

Example: If I put a gift on the chair next to you and told you that it was yours, don't ask me to give you a gift. Take what has already been given to you, open it and enjoy!

- Your focus needs to be on Jesus, not your sickness.
  - ◆ 1 Corinthians 11:28-30, But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Note: 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 says that people are sick, weak and die because they do not discern the Lord's body. Jesus paid the price for your healing and a miracle cure with His body, yet the tendency is to focus on the wrong body.

- Examine yourself and adjust your focus to the Lord's body.
- See yourself worthy to receive healing. You are not a slave, but a son and Jesus has given you the ability to receive.
- Sons do not run from father's gifts, but receive them with heads up and hands extended.
- Begging God to heal you is an unworthy attitude that keeps you from receiving. Healing is the children's bread (Matthew 15:26). Since the righteous do not have to beg for bread (Psalms 37:25), then they do not have to beg for healing either.
- Feeling unworthy did not keep you from getting saved, neither should it keep you from receiving healing.

Summary: 1 Corinthians 11:28-30 says that an unworthy attitude can cause Christians to be weak, sick and even die. A worthy attitude then, can cause Christians to be strong, well, and live.

◆ Isaiah 53:5, But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

- Matthew 8:16, When the evening was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.
- Healing is a fulfillment of God's Word. God's will and God's word agree. Healing is the will of God!
- You need to take a good look at the body of Jesus and understand what He did for you. He paid the price for all sin and sickness with His body. It is a miscarriage of justice for you to bear what Jesus has already borne.
- Redemption has two parts: <u>Healing and Salvation</u>. Jesus has provided for the healing of your body and mind just as much as He has for your salvation from sin and eternal damnation.
  - ◆ Luke 9:11, And the people, when they knew it, followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing.
- When you discern the price Jesus paid then it will help you claim the promise. The payment included both the cross and the whipping post. Consider the stripes Jesus endured to secure the promise of healing manifested in your body.

- You can get healed <u>before</u> you are saved. Healing was paid for <u>before</u> Jesus died on the cross.
  - You can be a sinful mess and still get healed. You got salvation when you were yet a sinner.
  - Your shortcomings, sins, situation, or condition of your body has nothing to do with getting your manifestation of healing.
    - ◆ James 5:14,15, Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 15and the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Note: The forgiveness of sin came after healing. If anybody tells you that God won't heal you unless you confess your sins first, don't buy it. Jesus didn't ask the people He ministered to to repent of sin first before he could heal them. You can deal with sin (if you have committed any) after you receive healing.

Example: John 5:9-13 describes the man by the pool of Bethesda who did not even know who Jesus was, but still received his healing that day.

Example: I prayed for a lady who was not born again and had no sense of feeling on her face. She had been in a severe car wreck and was dragged on her face across asphalt. Her face looked like hamburger meat. She was going to the hospital to endure skin grafts the next day. The next morning though, she was healed and the feeling came back into her face and she had brand new skin. Then she got saved!

#### Sickness and disease can end your life prematurely.

- You must settle in your heart that Jesus wants you to have a long life on this earth and anything less is not the will of God.
  - ◆ **Psalm 90:10** (New American Standard Bible), As for the days of our life, they <u>contain seventy years</u>, or if due to strength, eighty years, yet their pride is but labor and sorrow; for soon it is gone and we fly away.
  - ◆ **Deuteronomy 32:47,** For it is not a vain thing for you; because it is your life: and through this <u>thing ye shall prolong your days</u> in the land, whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.
  - ◆ **Philippians 1:22** (New International Reader's Version), Suppose I go on living in my body. Then I will be able to carry on my work. It will bear a lot of fruit. But what should I choose? I don't know.
  - ◆ 1 Samuel 14:45, And the people said unto Saul, Shall Jonathan die (they were going to leave it up to God), who hath wrought this great salvation in Israel? God forbid: as the LORD liveth, there shall not one hair of his head fall to the ground; for he hath wrought with God this day. So the people rescued Jonathan that he died not.
  - ◆ Job 42:17, So Job died, being old and full of days.
  - ◆ **Psalm 91:16**, <u>With long life</u> will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.
  - Proverbs 3:1, 2, My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.
  - Proverbs 4:10, Hear, O my son, and <u>receive</u> my sayings; and the <u>years of</u> thy life shall be many.
  - Proverbs 9:11, For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.
  - Proverbs 13:3, He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: but he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.
  - ◆ **John 10:10** (Contemporary English Version), Thief comes only to rob, kill, and destroy. I came so that everyone would have life, and have it in its fullest.
- Some people think God takes young people out of the earth, but John 10:10 says it is the devil that can take you out before your time. All death is not the will of God.

- People do die young but realize that not everything that happens is the will of God (Example: Is abortion the will of God? No, but it is happening).
- If you are not satisfied with your life, then fight the good fight of faith to stay alive, get well, and not accept leaving earth too early.
- Don't go to your heavenly home until you are satisfied. When you do go home to heaven, go home well.
- Since Jesus has paid the price for healing, don't let sickness or disease take you out. It is not the way God wants to bring you to your heavenly home.
- It is because of a lack of knowledge that God's people perish (Hosea 4: 6).

Example: I heard about an elderly preacher who told his daughter he was going home to heaven at a specific time. When she looked at the clock at that time, the man slumped over in his chair and was gone. He did not go sick or diseased, but ready and well!

**Daily Confession:** I will not die one day before I should. With long life God satisfies me. The number of my days will He fulfill in good health. My tongue is a tree of life and I speak life to my body.

Proverbs 15:4 Amplified Bible

#### Receiving by faith, that which has already been offered is a key ingredient to healing.

- Faith is very important to healing.
- You cannot physically see or grasp hold of your healing; you must believe you receive what you cannot see.
- A gift given is not necessarily a gift received. You must receive healing by faith.
  - ◆ Romans 12:3, For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
  - ◆ **Hebrews 4:2,** For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being <u>mixed</u> with faith in them that heard it.
  - ◆ Acts 14:9, The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had faith to be healed.
  - Acts 3:16, And his name through faith in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the faith, which is by him, hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.
  - **Hebrews 11:1,** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
  - ◆ Galatians 3:14, The blessing of Abraham come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Example: If you bake a cake but forget the key ingredient of flour, you will have to start again. Faith is vital to receiving your healing.

- See God's Word as a "now" word for you today, not someday in the future (Luke 4:21).
  - Just believing to be healed puts healing in the future and you can never catch up to the future. When you pray, you have to believe that you've received.
  - Thank God that the Word is working in you now! Believe and confess that the Word is producing healing and health in your body now.
    - ◆ **Luke 4:21**, And he began to say unto them, This <u>day</u> is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.
    - **Hebrews 11:1**, Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
    - ◆ Mark 11:23,24, ... Does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them (now), and you will have them.
    - ◆ 1 Peter 2:24, ....By whose stripes you were healed.

#### Summary: Having believed today will change tomorrow.

- See God's Word as a green light, not a red light. He wants you to go after all He has provided for you. Don't stop and wait for Him to do something.
- Today is the day of salvation; today is the day for healing.
  - ◆ 2 Corinthians 1:20, For all the promises of God in him are <u>yea</u>, and in him <u>Amen (so be it)</u>, unto the glory of God <u>by us</u>.



- See the accounts of healing in the Bible as <u>proof</u> that God wants you well.
  - Healing is very important to God because He made it a priority to include many testimonies of people healed in the Bible.
  - See yourself as one of the ones who were made perfectly whole in Matthew 14:36.
    - ◆ Matthew 14:36, And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.
    - ◆ **Psalm 119:111** (New American Standard Bible), I have inherited your testimonies forever, for they are the joy of my heart.
    - ◆ Matthew 21:14, And the blind and the lame came to him in the temple; and he healed them.
    - ◆ Mark 4:24, And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him <u>all sick people</u> that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them.
    - ◆ Mark 10:47, And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me.

Example: Blind Bartimaeus was healed in Jesus' presence and you can be too, Mark 10:46-52.

## • If any man is in Christ he is a <u>new creature</u>. If you are Christ's, you have a new family tree.

- Change your thinking about hereditary health problems.
- If you have disorders or diseases that you think have been passed down from your family, it stops when you are in Christ.
- Just because your parents had a disease doesn't mean you have to.
- Now you are part of <u>God's</u> family tree. Your father God and brother Jesus have no health problems and they pass their good health down to you.
- You are redeemed from the curse of sickness and disease (Deuteronomy 28).

Summary: Every tree produces fruit of its own kind. Good trees should produce good fruit. You are a good tree now!

- The curse says you will be sick from head to toe but the blessing says the opposite, so claim the blessing (Galatians 3:13).
- The curse says that you would not have assurance of life, but the blessing assures you that you can live long and not die prematurely.
- The curse was pronounced by God under the law (Old Testament) to point to your need of a redeemer and healer.
- The cross has canceled out everything that the curse pronounced over you. It is up to you not to let the curse operate illegally in your body.
  - ◆ Deuteronomy 28:35,60 -61, 65-67, The LORD shall smite thee in the knees, and in the legs, with a sore botch that cannot be healed, from the sole of thy foot unto the top of thy head. Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee. Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed. And among these nations shalt thou find no ease, neither shall the sole of thy foot have rest: but the LORD shall give (allow) thee there a trembling heart, and failing of eyes, and sorrow of mind: And thy life shall hang in doubt before thee; and thou shalt fear day and night, and shalt have none assurance of thy life: In the morning thou shalt say, Would God it were even! and at even thou shalt say, Would God it were morning! For the fear of thine heart wherewith thou shalt fear, and for the sight of thine eyes which thou shalt see.

Note: These verses sound like what many believers are experiencing today, but it is <u>all</u> part of the curse that you have been redeemed from.

- Galatians 3:13 (Contemporary English Version), But Christ rescued us from the Law's curse, when he became a curse in our place. This is because the Scriptures say that anyone who is nailed to a tree is under a curse. That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ.
- Deuteronomy 28:2, And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.
- **Proverbs 26:2** (Darby Translation), As the sparrow for flitting about, as the swallow for flying, so a curse undeserved shall not come.

Note: There is no reason for the curse to come in the New Testament Age because it has been dealt with through the cross.

- ◆ **Psalm 118:17**, I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.
- Generational curses passed down to the third and forth generations were only valid under the Old Covenant.

Note: Generational curses came onto people because they could not keep the law.

- Acts 7:53, You received the law as it was ordained by angels, and didn't keep it.
- Christ has become a curse and fulfilled all righteousness. Christ has redeemed you and broken all generational curses with the ratification of the New Covenant.

◆ **Galatians 3:13**, Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, cursed is every one that hangs on a tree.

Note: Numbers 14:18 and Deuteronomy 5:9 describe the generational curses, but Ezekiel 18:1-30 and Jeremiah 31:29-34 proclaims the coming New Covenant realities. You are not held captive to your ancestors' sins; you are only responsible for your own.

◆ Ezekiel 18:1-3, The word of the Lord came unto me again, saying, what mean ye, that ye use this proverb concerning the land of Israel, saying, the fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge?

As I live, saith the Lord God, ye shall not have occasion any more to use this proverb in Israel.

Note: In other words, generational curses have been done away with in the New Testament.

Jeremiah 31:29, In those days (New Testament days) they shall say no more, the fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge. Every one shall die for his own iniquity; every man that eateth the sour grape, his own teeth shall be set on edge.

Note: In the New Testament there are no more occasions to speak about generational curses. In addition, God specifically says not to say any more that your problem is a generational one. Jesus has set you free from the sins of your fathers and you are not penalized for their actions. The devil would like you to think your problem has been passed down but that is deception from the enemy, don't receive it.

Example: If someone comes to your door and says, "here, these were your father's rattlesnakes and now they're yours." Don't accept the snakes!

#### No matter what you have done, God wants you well!

- If you think a door is open in your life to sickness and you must accept the consequences, THINK AGAIN. Jesus has paid for it all by His actions!
- A door could be something you did to yourself like smoking, drug use, alcohol addiction, eating disorder, etc. This doesn't mean you have to resign yourself to suffer the health consequences of it. No! Jesus paid the price for your health based on His grace, not how deserving you are.

Example: If a door is left open at your house when you go to town, and upon arriving back home you discover a thief has entered your house. He is eating your food, watching your TV, and assuming he belongs there since you left a door open. Do you accept and welcome him since you left the door open? No, you kick him out anyway!

- If you have behaviors that have become destructive to your well-being, don't think that you can't be healed until you get your problems solved.
- I Peter 2:24 says, "that by His stripes you were healed". It doesn't say that by His stripes and no currently existing health problems, you were healed.
- Your health (or lack of it) doesn't have anything to do with your healing. It's good to maintain healthy habits, but not doing so cannot stop you from receiving your healing. Jesus paid the price for you to walk in health, no matter what issues your body suffers from.
- Get your healing, then purpose to do what you can to stay healthy with good nutrition, exercise, and rest.

Note: It is important to be health conscience and treat your body well. Some diseases can be health related and some sickness can be from ignorance. For those that have a healthy lifestyle, you must also put your faith in Jesus' healing power to live long, not in your own healthy choices. Certainly a healthier lifestyle might prevent you from having many health problems but people have died prematurely who were the picture of health and fitness.

Example: It's easier to not get on the plane (maintain good health) than have to believe God that you won't die as it's falling from the sky (believe God to restore poor health).

#### Your environment is <u>not</u> that important.

- The anointing breaks the yoke, not feelings or atmosphere.
- The anointing is in you, so you can be healed in any environment at any time or place.
- Because the Holy Spirit never leaves you, the healing power of Jesus is ever present.
- Church services complete with dancing, shouting, and praising are great, but you can receive your healing anywhere (even at McDonald's).
- Believe and expect the manifested presence of the Lord to be seen in churches, but don't think you have to have a glory cloud in order to receive from the Lord. If that were the case then no one would be healed outside the church.

Note: Naaman the leper was healed in a muddy river. Lazarus was raised from the dead in a tomb. The woman with the issue of blood was healed on a busy street. The lame man in Acts 3 was healed outside the church. Jairus' daughter was raised from the dead at her home.

Example: I prayed for a girl at the outdoor market in Cluj, Romania in 1999. She was born deaf and needed creative miracles in both ears. Right there in the <u>busy market</u> she was completely healed and heard words and sounds for the first time.

■ You don't need a thirty-minute prayer service to release God's healing power. Jesus never said wait until I pray for a while then I can minister to you. God's anointing is ever present so be ready to receive your healing or minister healing to someone else.

- In 1 Kings 19:19 Elijah walked by Elisha and quickly threw his mantle on him and he was anointed.
- 1 Samuel 16:13 says that Samuel poured oil on David and the Spirit of the Lord came on David from that day forward. There was no pre-anointing prayer service.
- In Luke 4:18 Jesus said, "God has anointed me," not, "I feel it, so I must be anointed." Jesus knew the Father anointed him, whether he felt it or not.
- Separate feeling the anointing from knowing that the anointing is always present. Manifestations are not the anointing; but rather your responses to it.
- When your hand starts shaking and feeling the power, that doesn't mean at that moment you are anointed. You have just become more aware of His presence.

Note: Just because you don't feel the anointing for salvation in church doesn't mean God is not there to save. That anointing is always there in any circumstance. It's the same with healing. It is not just when someone feels God's anointing that He is there to heal; the power of the Lord is always present to heal. No one sensed the power of the Lord in Luke 5:17, but it was present.

- ◆ **Isaiah 10:27**, And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.
  - -Not because of the environment.

Summary: You cannot duplicate the atmosphere of a church service in the market place. It is not practical to carry a portable device around for playing special music when you are not in church.

You have the Holy Spirit inside you and can manifest the healing power without music or a special song regardless of how anointed you may or may not feel.

- Philemon verse 6 says you become effective by acknowledging every good thing in you. Acknowledge who is in you since salvation. See His anointing in you, be "God-inside" minded.
- You flow in more anointing when you are aware of His presence.
- Learn how to respond effortlessly when healing is needed, no matter the environment.

Example: Just because I don't sense my wife near doesn't mean she is not in the room. I don't need my wife to hug me to know she is near.

◆ **John 5:4**, For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.

Note: Jesus told the sick man that he didn't need the water stirred up for healing. Why? The healer was right next to him at that moment and ready to heal him of his disease. You don't necessarily need the church service stirred up to get something from God either.

- You can't always change an atmosphere, but you can be heaven's atmosphere! You are the mystery of the glory of God; let it be revealed!
  - Colossians 1:27b, Christ in you the hope of glory.
  - ◆ Acts 3:5-6, And he (the lame man) gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them. The Peter said, silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

- Even in church, conditions don't have to be perfect to see a healing. Realize that in most places you will not have ideal conditions. Generally there will always be people talking, texting, coming and going or a baby crying. Receive from God anyway and get your healing!
- Thank God the Word says, "by His stripes you were healed", not "by His stripes and a perfect environment you were healed".

Note: Luke 5:17-24 tells the story of four men who busted up the roof of the house church to get their friend healed. All the noise and chaos didn't stop the healing power of the Holy Spirit. Even in the midst of debris falling, dust stirring and people gasping in shock, a man got healed!

#### Healing Is A Seed.

- See your healing in seed form.
  - Mark 4:26, And he said, so is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground.
  - ◆ Mark 4:30-32, And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? Or with what comparison shall we compare it? It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth. But when it is sown, it growth up and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches.
  - Mark 4:26, declares that the Kingdom of Heaven operates like a man sowing a seed. This means that healing operates as a man sowing a seed.

Note: When studying the bible, it is vital to understand the fourth chapter in the book of Mark. It is considered the master parable to unlock the mysteries of God. If you understand this chapter then you will know how the Kingdom of God operates. In Mark 4:13, Jesus said to his disciples, know this parable and then you will know all parables. A parable is a natural example used to convey spiritual truths. Mark 4:26 states that the Kingdom of God is as a man casting seed into the ground. You need to receive the seed and be good ground for things to grow in. Realize that like a seed, things take time to grow and become established. Your harvest is in the seed!

- When you sow a seed your harvest is in the seed. In the seed is 100% harvest, but it needs time to manifest to 100%.
- Mark 4:32, says that when the seed is sown it will grow up and shoot out great branches. A seed has to be planted and grow before it is seen.
- The seed is still working underground even though you don't see anything above ground. Your healing is working even if you don't see it manifested.

Note: When a farmer sows seed in the ground, he never says it's not working.

- When you first receive prayer for healing the seed is sown and you are 100% healed inside but you do not yet have 100% manifestation on the outside. From this point on, you don't start from zero when you get prayer again. The seed of healing is in you and your healing is growing.
- You may be at 30% manifestation of a 100% healing seed, so keep growing until you get a full crop of healing. Don't dig up the seed, but water it with words of faith.
  - ◆ Mark 4:20, And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirty, some sixty, some an hundredfold.
- Sometimes when I pray for people they feel better, but not fully recovered. This means they have some manifestation and the rest will come. They have the complete seed planted but need to water the seed for growth. If you see a complete healing manifested then that means you had an instant miracle grow, which is great!

Example: However, when a farmer doesn't see an immediate harvest it doesn't mean that he has not planted the seed. He knows the seed is in the ground taking root and sprouting and that harvest will come in due time.

- ◆ Mark 4:26, And he said, so is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground, and should sleep and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.
- ◆ Mark 4:22, For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested...
- ◆ Mark 8:24, And he looked up and said "I see men as trees, walking." After that Jesus put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.
  - Healing took time to manifest.

Note: Healing is like a woman who is pregnant. The seed is planted although no one can see that she is with child. She starts to manifest weeks later. Upon giving birth, her manifestation is 100% complete. A woman who has given birth no longer says she is pregnant, but that she was pregnant. From then on she would not say, "I'm pregnant". You are healed after the healing seed is planted inside you. You were healed when it has brought forth harvest (manifestation). 1 Peter 2:24 "by His stripes you were healed". Believe and say, "healing is fully manifested in me and seen by all, to God be the glory!" Jesus not only made provision for your healing, but He sees you as completely well with manifested healing.

#### Healing in many cases does not manifest instantly, unless it is through a gift of healing.

- It takes patience to see full manifestations.
- You must be patient and believe day and night. Galatians 6:9 says if you faint you do not reap, so your healing has a lot to do with you.
- Your part of watering the seed is vital to God's part, which is giving the harvest.
- Through faith and patience you inherit the promises. Just like a seed planted takes time to grow, so the supernatural seed of God's healing grows in you.

Example: A farmer doesn't harvest right after he plants. He has to be patient. Yes, you should believe for instant manifestations (miracles) but be willing to have patience if your healing doesn't manifest right away.

- ◆ Galatians 6:9 (Amplified Bible), And let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint.
- ◆ Hebrews 10:36 (Amplified Bible), For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and carry away [and enjoy to the full] what is promised.

Summary: Healing starts from the inside and grows outwardly. You may feel and look the same on the outside, but the roots are growing.

- The gift of healing vs. the seed of healing.
  - You can receive a gift of healing which is an instant manifestation given by the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:28).
  - There are some cases where you don't have time to see a seed planted and grow to full manifestation. I believe God gave us the gifts of healing for these special cases where a person must see manifestation immediately or they may die.
  - The Holy Spirit gives a gift of healing as he wills, but a seed of healing can be planted anytime and produce healing in whoever receives it. See more on the gifts of Healing, page 63.

### Healing Manifestation Helpers

#### Confession speeds manifestations

- It's vital to speak and declare in faith the scriptures that pertain to healing and health over yourself. Do it daily to maintain a strong resistance against any symptoms or illness.
  - Mark 11:23, For verily I <u>say</u> unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he <u>says</u> shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he <u>says</u>.
- The English word <u>"say"</u> in the Greek is <u>"lego"</u> which means systematic daily speaking. The words you speak routinely everyday are the building blocks of your life. Speak words that build your healing.
  - ◆ Mark 4:25,28, And a certain woman which had an issue of blood twelve years, for she said (lego), If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

Summary: Compare your healing to a building being built. First you lay the foundation (receive the healing seed). Then you put the walls up (your "lego"- daily speaking over your healing). The building is not complete until all the walls are up and the roof is in place. Your healing needs words of faith to complete the work.

Fourteen times in Genesis when God created the world it is recorded that He "said". He did not "say" just once or twice. Learn from God and follow His lead.

- Matthew 6:7 says not to use vain repetition which means non-working words or babble. Speaking God's word over and over is not vain repetition, but effective, working words.
- Keep saying systematically every day that your body resists sickness and disease and healing is completely manifested.
- Psalms 103:5 says God satisfies your mouth with good things. Speak good things and you will be satisfied with your healing.
- Proverbs 18:20 says that when you increase your speaking you will be filled.
- Isaiah 57:19 says that God creates the fruit of your lips. You give him the substance to create with, which is your words.
- Hebrews 3:1 states that Jesus is the high priest of your confession. You supply the words and He brings them to pass.
- Christianity is known as the "great confession".
- In Jesus' day they marveled not at his height, looks or clothes but at his words.
- Words are the keys to the Kingdom (Matthew 18:18). Words are seeds that grow into a harvest.

Example: I ministered to a lady in Cuba who had been diagnosed with lung cancer and sent home to die. After I prayed, I told her daughter Mabel to speak words of life over her every day (to declare she would live and not die). Eighteen months later her doctor declared her completely healed and cancer-free.

- ◆ Matthew 8:8, The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.
- ◆ 2 Corintians 4:13, We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe and therefore speak.
- Romans 4:17, ...God who quickeneth the dead, and <u>called</u> (Kalelo) those things which be not as though they were.
- Called: "Kalelo;" which means to give a name to and then call by the name given.
- You call a person daily by the name they have. You need to name your healing and call it everyday.

Summary: God gave Abram the new name Abraham (father of nations). Isaac was called laughter. Call your healing by name; "I am the healed and healthy one, I am strong and full of life."

- ◆ **Proverbs 12:18**, .... The tongue of the wise is health.
- Gather a book full of healing scripture and confessions and make it part of your daily life!

Daily Confession: My body is off limits to sickness and disease. 1 Peter 2:24 is flowing in my blood, marrow, organs and tissue. My bones and joints will not respond to swelling and pain because the life of God works in them. My blood pressure is 120 over 80. My heart is strong and functions perfectly. My immune system works well and my youth and energy are renewed. God's Word is medicine to all my flesh.

- Jesus resisted the devil with His words. You must resist the devil with your words.
- Your mouth is involved in your miracle. If the Son of God had to stand against the devil with His words, then you must follow His example (Luke 4:4).
- Speaking to the mountain (Mark 11:23) is just as important as speaking to God about the mountain. Whatsoever <u>you</u> bind on earth (Matthew 18:18) is bound in heaven ---<u>not</u> whatsoever God binds for you. To "bind" is to "cut off" and you do this with your words. You also loose with your words the healing power of God to manifest.
- Speak against the disease daily and speak to your healing that it manifests fully. Anything that God has not planted in you needs to be uprooted, and you uproot things with your words. Say, "Diseases or sickness leave this body now in Jesus' name!" "I am healed and my body fully manifests healing in the name of Jesus!"

Note: Proverbs 18:21 declares that death and life are in the power of your tongue. You can end sickness and impart life with your words.

- ◆ Luke 4:4, And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.
- Proverbs 18:21, Death and life are in the power of the tongue and those who love it will eat the fruit thereof.
- **Proverbs 12:6,** .... The mouth of the upright shall deliver them.
- Proverbs 12:14, A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of his mouth.
- ◆ Mark 11:23 (Darby Translation), Verily I say to you, that whosoever shall say to this mountain, Be thou taken away and cast into the sea, and shall not doubt in his heart, but believe that what he says takes place, whatever he shall say shall come to pass for him.
- ◆ Matthew 18:18 (Holman Christian Standard Bible), I assure you: Whatever you bind on earth is already bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth is already loosed in heaven.
- ◆ Matthew 18:18 (Contemporary English Version), I promise you that God in heaven will allow whatever you allow on earth, but he will not allow anything you don't allow.
- ◆ Matthew 15:13 (Amplified Bible), He answered; every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be torn up by the roots.
- ◆ Job 5:3 (Young's Literal Translation), I have seen the perverse taking root, and I mark (cursed) his habitation straightway.
- Matthew 12:33 tells you to make the tree good, you must do the rooting out.

Example: If someone breaks into your house, do you let him take your goods out the door without saying a word? No! Your words are your first line of defense to stop the crime.

- Illnesses are varied and sometimes your manifestation of healing requires a different faith action than that of someone else. Find out if you need to do something specific.
  - Listening to God is part of seeing your healing manifest.

Example: I had to run when I had kidney stones to get healing to manifest in my body, but that does not mean everyone has to run to experience healing.

- Naaman dipped seven times in the Jordan to be healed, but not everyone has to. (Luke 4:27).
- You need to obey what God is saying to you because faith without works is dead.
- God may impress someone to have a surgical procedure and if they do not, then they might die because they did not act.
- You must find out from God exactly what you need to do and follow it precisely to see your healing manifest.
- If Naaman had dipped 6 times instead of 7, then he would have missed it. You could be doing everything God said in your situation but omit one detail and delay a manifestation.
  - ◆ 1 John 3:22 (The Message), And friends, once that's taken care of and we're no longer accusing or condemning ourselves, we're bold and free before God! We're able to stretch our hands out and receive what we asked for because we're doing what he said, doing what pleases him.
  - ◆ John 9:11, He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

Summary: If you fail to correctly read the road map, you may end up in the wrong place. If you fail to heed what the Lord says, you could needlessly suffer.

#### Worshipping God waters the healing seed.

- ◆ **John 9:31**, Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.
- ◆ Acts 16:14, And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.
- ◆ Matthew 8:2, And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. <sup>3</sup>And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- ◆ John 9:38, And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

Summary: Worship God before you see your healing and you will be praising Him afterwards.

A worshiper is who you are but worship is what you give. You can worship God anywhere and in doing so you are watering the healing seed.

Example: My son Justin broke his wrist when he was about 5 years old. The family was in a truck on a long stretch of highway. It was the middle of night, pouring down rain and more that 60 miles from the nearest town. I gathered him up in my arms and prayed. The Lord told me to worship Him even as Justin was screaming. After I started worshiping God and eventually lost sight of the problem, I realized my son wasn't crying anymore. When I opened my eyes he was completely normal and looking at me.

- God's Word is medicine and the more you "take it" the better you get.
  - You cannot overdose on God's Word and there are no harmful side effects.
    - ◆ **Proverbs 16:24**, Pleasant words (God's Words) are as a honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.
    - Proverbs 4:20-22, My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.
    - ◆ Jeremiah 46:11 (Amplified Bible), Go up into Gilead and take [healing] balm, O Virgin Daughter of Egypt! In vain do you use many medicines; for you there is no healing or remedy (the Word is the best medicine).
    - ◆ **Psalms 1:2,3**, But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Example: If you will religiously follow what the doctor prescribes, why not be faithful to obey God's prescription of His Word?



#### Working like medicine, the joy of the Lord is your strength.

- Proverbs 17:22, A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit dries the bones.
- ◆ **Psalms 16:11,** Thou wilt show me the path of life: in thy presence is fullness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Note: Happiness is circumstantial but joy is internal. Joy is a fruit of the Spirit that can grow even in sickness.

- ◆ Nehemiah 8:10, Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our LORD: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.
- ◆ **Psalms 18:39**, For thou hast girded me with <u>strength</u> unto the battle: thou hast subdued under me those that rose up against me.
- ◆ 2 Corinthians 7:4, Great is my boldness of speech toward you. Great is my boasting on your behalf. I am filled with comfort. I overflow with joy in all afflictions.

Example: It is commonly reported that people have been healed of various sicknesses by watching a steady stream of comedy shows. Laughter and rejoicing are good for you.

**Daily Confession:** The joy of the Lord is my strength to sustain me and conquer this sickness. I will rejoice and be glad because your Word is working mightily in me.

#### Do not testify too early about your healing.

- You do not share your harvest with others until it has come in.
- When you start to see your healing sprout up, keep watering (releasing the anointing and speaking the Word) until it is fully manifested and then share your testimony with others.
  - ◆ Mark 4:28, 29, For the earth brings forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. <sup>29</sup>But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest is come.
  - ◆ 1 John 4:14, And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world.

Example: You can't share your vegetables with your neighbor until it's in hand.

Example: I knew a man that had believed God for healing and was even on TV proclaiming that God had healed him and he was cancer-free. His healing had not fully manifested though and he died several days later. Many people doubted God and quit church in that city. It would have been much better if he had kept patiently watering the healing seed until his healing was 100% manifested.

**Daily Confession:** Lord I will be patient and wait for my full manifestation of healing. I will continue doing my part watering the seed. Please help me keep my words in alignment with yours, and not testify too early.

#### What you make happen for others God will bring to pass for you.

- Pray for others who are sick and minister to them. Even if you are feeling sick, do not let it stop you from praying for others.
- This is God's eternal principle of sowing and reaping.
  - ◆ Matthew 7:12, Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them.
  - Philippians 2:4, Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.
  - ◆ Galatians 6:10, As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all me, especially unto the household of faith.
  - ◆ Galations 6:7, ... Whatsoever a man sows, that shall he also reap.

Example: Job ministered to his friends before his own captivity was turned (Job 42:7-10).

- ◆ **Job 42:10,** And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends.
- ◆ **Ephesians 6:8**, Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free.

**Daily Confession:** Lord, as I trust you for my healing, I ask you to bring someone across my path that needs encouragement. I will help and pray for others that are sick that they might be blessed, and I know I will be too.

- As long as you have breath, suffer against sickness and disease, not with it.
  - You suffer against it with your words leading the way. "I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge, my fortress, my healer".... Psalms 91.
    - ◆ Romans 8:18, For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
    - ◆ Matthew 8:8, The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: <u>but speak the word only, and my</u> servant shall be healed.
    - Psalm 107:20, He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.
    - Romans 10:8, But what saith it? The word is night hee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach.
    - lacktriangle Jeremiah 23:29, Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like <u>a</u> hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?
  - Keep hammering with your words!

Summary: When you suffer with something, you accept it; but if you suffer against something, you resist it.

- If you are not seeing your healing manifest after some length of time, fasting may speed up the manifestation.
  - Fasting helps you deal with your unbelief, especially the stubborn kind.
    - ◆ Isaiah 58:6-8, Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? <sup>8</sup>Then shall thy light break forth as the morning and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward.

Summary: Fasting doesn't change God. Fasting deals with you so that you can more readily receive from God.

■ Fasting causes your eye to become single towards God.

**Matthew 6:22a,** The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light.

- Fasting will produce results.
  - Mark 9:29, And he said unto them, This kind (stubborn unbelief) can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.

#### Rest in God's grace daily!

- ◆ Mark 4:26 (Amplified Bible), And He said, The kingdom of God is like a man who scatters seed upon the ground, And then continues sleeping and rising night and day (you could say resting in grace) while the seed sprouts and grows and increases—he knows not how.
- Grace is getting what you do not deserve. It is also God's supernatural empowerment to deal with any problem.
- Even if you are struggling with your faith, keep resting in God's grace.
- Your healing is not based on your performance; it is based on what Jesus has already done and the power of His Word.
  - Acts 4:33, And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.
  - Romans 5:17, For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.
  - ◆ 2 Corinthians 6:1, We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain.
  - ◆ **Hebrews 4:16**, Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Summary: By grace are you saved <u>and</u> healed, not by your own efforts. It is God's gift to you. If healing is already given, then you don't have to earn it.

#### After healing has manifest completely you must hold on to it. Here are some keys to keeping your manifestation.

#### ■ Run from sin.

- o Psalms 84:11 says walking free of sin releases good things in your life.
- Psalm 84:11, For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.
- ◆ **Hebrews 3:17**, But with whom was he grieved forty years? Was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?
- ◆ Romans 12:9, Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.

#### Stay humble.

- o James 4:6 says that God resists the proud.
- ◆ James 4:6, But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

#### ■ Walk in love.

- o 1 John 3:14 says if you do not love your brother you abide in death.
- ◆ 1 John 3:14, We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.
- ◆ 1 John 4:16b, God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in Him.

#### ■ Let go of un-forgiveness.

- o Forgive since you have received so much of God's forgiveness yourself.
- Psalms 86:5, For you Lord are good and ready to forgive, and abundant in mercy to all those who call upon you.
- Mark 11:25, And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Note: This verse in Mark 11:25 was given before Jesus died while the Old Covenant was still in effect. You are forgiven when you ask, no matter what you have done because of the blood of Jesus. You should forgive others in the same way because of how much you have been forgiven.

- ◆ **Ephesians 4:32**, And be kind to one another, tenderhearted forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.
- Don't strive.
  - James 3:16 says "where strife is there is <u>every</u> evil work", so how can healing function?
  - James 3:16, For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.
- Replace carnal thinking with a renewed mind.
  - 1 Corinthians 3:3 says that the carnal mind is against God and to be carnally minded is death.
  - o Death and keeping your healing do not go together.
  - ◆ 1 Corinthians 3:3, For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?
- Refuse to doubt-only believe!
  - Mark 6:5 says Jesus the son of God could not do any <u>mighty</u> works because of unbelief. It does not say that He could not do any works because He did heal a few sick people, nor does it say that He did not <u>want</u> to do mighty works.
  - Mark 6:5,6, And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. And He marveled because of their unbelief.
  - ◆ James 1:6,7, But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

## Ministry Of Healing.

 Before you minister to others you must settle forever that healing is the will of God.

- Psalms 107:20 says He sent his word, and healed them. His word declares healing!
- His will is His word and there is no contradiction or scriptural reason why you cannot see someone healed.
- Always minister with this in mind, and the devil won't even try to talk you out of ministering to someone in severe need.
- God's will is to heal and restore, no matter how great or complicated the need.
- There is only one kind of Jesus portrayed in the bible. He is a healing Jesus. This will never change!
  - Malachi 4:2, .....The son of righteousness shall arise with healing in his wings.
  - Matthew 4:23, Jesus went about in all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing every</u> disease and every sickness among the people.
  - ◆ Hebrews 13:8, Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and forever.

Don't promote healing	the sick	as an	unusual	or	rare
event.					

- It should be an every day occurrence everywhere you go since it is a sign that follows believers.
  - ◆ Mark 16:17-18, And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name they shall speak with new tongues: they shall take up serpents, and if they drink deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Scripture shows us in Mark 16: 17-18 that laying hands on the sick is not a special event, but rather part of an everyday lifestyle of a believer.
  - ◆ **Luke 9:6,** They departed, and went throughout the villages, preaching the gospel, and **healing everywhere.**
- You don't require a special leading from the Lord to pray for the sick. You have a commission to do so in Mark 16:15-20 and Matthew 28:18-20. Any sick person you see (saved or not) can be a person to minister to. You have been authorized and empowered to lay hands on the sick. You are needed to fulfill the great commission because the sick are waiting.

### God has done His part to secure healing. You don't have to plead with God to get him to heal.

- It's already done and available! Now healing needs to be planted and manifested.
- Never ask God if it is His will to heal a person. Instead thank Him that it is! You only ask a question when you are uncertain of the answer. God's will and power to heal are certain.
- It is unnecessary to ask God for what He has already provided. It is a prayer He cannot answer. But you can be the one that plants the healing seed.
- Release healing. Use faith, words, and touch to impart healing into another.
- Then thank God for the increase, the person's manifested healing.
  - ◆ **John 17:4**, I have glorified thee on the earth: <u>I have finished the work</u> which thou gavest me to do.
  - ◆ **John 19:30,** When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, <u>it is</u> finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
  - Matthew 8:17, That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.
    ---- It's done!

Example: I would be wasting my time by asking my wife to marry me because she already has.

### You have authority to bind sickness and rebuke spirits of infirmity.

- ◆ Luke 10:8-9, And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you, and heal the sick that are therein and say unto them, the Kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- ◆ Mark 16:18, They shall take up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- ◆ Luke 9:1, Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure disease.

Example: Jesus made a whip and with authority drove out the thieves selling in the temple. You can drive out the thieves robbing people of their vitality and health with the same authority.

- Acts 10:38 says that Jesus is anointed with the Holy Ghost and power who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil.
- Healing many times involves commanding the devil and you must do this with authority.

Note: Jesus is waiting in heaven until His enemies are made his footstool (Hebrews 10:13). Jesus wants <u>you</u> to drive out the enemies of God. Sickness is one of those enemies. You cannot drive out sickness without knowing who you are in Christ and using that authority.

### You must see yourself as anointed and having power to release healing.

- ◆ 2 Corinthians 1:21, Now he that established us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God.
- ◆ Acts 3:6, Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
- You have a healing anointing from the day of salvation because you have the healer living inside you.

Summary: You have the same Spirit in you as Jesus. You did not get Holy Spirit "B" or "C". You have the same healing anointing as Jesus. You don't need a special anointing to pray for the sick.

- The anointing flows when you realize He is in you and He wants to heal everyone.
- What you are aware of, you will manifest.
- Genuine compassion for those you minister to will compel you.
  - ◆ Matthew 14:14, Jesus went out, and he saw a great multitude. He had compassion on them, and healed their sick.
- Faith is your positive response to what God has done. Your faith will help others enter into their healing.
- A great man of God once said, "the man of God can manifest the Spirit of God at will". In other words, God is always willing!

- Healing was meant to flow more from the believer to the sick, than from heaven.
  - ◆ Mark 16:18, ... They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- Healing has to be planted by you, but God gives the growth and increase.
  - ◆ Isaiah 61:1, The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound.
  - Romans 8:11, But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you.
- 1 Corinthians 1:7 states that you do not fall short of any gift. You are enriched in His full ability. You are anointed to lay hands on the sick.

Daily Confession: I am anointed to minister to the sick. The Holy Spirit is living big in me. Waters of healing flow out of me. I believe that when I lay hands on the sick they do recover as the bible says. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. There is a wellspring of life that springs up in me to others. Goodness and mercy follow me all the days of my life. The Lord is working with me to help me release the healing anointing to those in need.

 Healing is a work of God that requires your cooperation.

Example: The Holy Spirit works with you but doesn't do all the work. It would be like me agreeing to help my wife cook dinner but she did all the preparation and cooking. When you help, you work together.

- Mark 16:20, And they went out and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them and confirming the word with signs following.
- You have to do something! Laying on of hands, speaking to sickness, prophetic words for the sick to act upon, rebuking devils, releasing life into the person, and other things as the Lord impresses you is your part in the healing process.
- In Luke 5:17 the power of the Lord was present to heal, but no one was healed until someone acted in faith. Understand that a healing is not just dependent on the power of God, but also faith to release it.
- Jesus said in John 9:4 that He must work the work. Healing is a work of God that you must work.
- Faith and God's power work together! <u>Faith appropriates what His grace has already provided</u>. Take salvation for instance, it is a gift of His grace, but without faith you are not saved. Faith has to receive what grace has given. It works the same in ministering healing.
  - Luke 5:17, ...And the power of the Lord was present to heal them. <u>Verse</u>
     20, and when he saw their faith. <u>Verse 25</u>, and immediately he rose up before them.

Note: <u>Believers</u> should minister to the sick. If you want to see the power manifested then you have to do your part. Move out and start laying hands on the sick. Mark 16:18 did not specify pastors, evangelists, prophets would lay hands on the sick (which they can and should do), but for the believers to start doing it. God wants to use the body of Christ to release His virtue. The corporate anointing will come from corporate ministry.

Acts 10:38 tells us how God anointed Jesus. <u>He went about doing good by healing!</u> Jesus gave God an avenue of expression. In Acts 1:1, Jesus began His ministry like the Fourth of July with a display of healings, but He did not finish His earthly ministry. Yes, He died on the cross and finished the plan of redemption – but His ministry on this earth needs <u>His Body (needs you)</u> to complete it.

- ◆ Matthew 5:6, Let your light so shine before men, that they may <u>see your</u> good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- ◆ 2 Corinthians 4:6, For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to [give] the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Note: Electricity is a natural example of how spiritual power works. Electricity illuminates the room for anyone who turns on the switch. The power of God illuminates the environment, no matter how dark it is. It just has to be activated. You can have electricity flowing through the power lines and be properly connected to the house, but unless the switch is turned on you will sit in darkness all night. You must flip the switch by going about <u>doing good</u> and trusting Him <u>to light up every dark situation</u> and hurting person you come in contact with.

- God's power works for any believer who will release it!
- The power of God doesn't care which believer releases healing.

 It's nice, but you do not need a special atmosphere or powerful service to minister to the sick in.

- Ministering healing to people does not have to be influenced by the environment.
- The healing power is always present in any environment, but must be released. In Luke 5:17, the healing power was present for all, but only one man got healed. Also, nobody sensed the power but it <u>was there.</u>
- It is all about the anointing in you and releasing it!
- You can release the anointing in any atmosphere.
- Jesus set the example by healing everywhere, not just in anointed believers meetings.
- He healed in places where people were running, screaming, angry, scared, debating religion, and other less than ideal situations.

Note: The apostle Peter did not say to the man he ministered to at the temple gate that first he had to sing to get the healing anointing stirred up. The man got healed outdoors, just the way things were (Act 3:1-3).

Example: I prayed for two people in a hospital in Tennessee. With one I felt the power of God in my hand and with the other I felt nothing. The lady, who I prayed for and felt a strong anointing, died. The man in a coma that I prayed for but felt nothing, came out of it the next day. Sensing the anointing is not as important as releasing the anointing by faith.

Note: The power of God does not fluctuate. His power is ever present. God's healing power is always present to heal. The issue is awareness and releasing it for others. You do this by faith because many times it is undetectable to your physical senses.

- Just because you feel the anointing doesn't mean you released it.
- It is not about feelings; you release the anointing by faith.
- When releasing the power use a point of contact.
  - Luke 13:13, And he laid his hands (point of contact) on her; and immediately she was made straight and glorified God.
  - ◆ Mark 5:28, For she said, if I may touch (point of contact) but his clothes, I shall be whole.
- Once it is released the benefit is received. The more you learn how to release, the more healings you will see.

 See healing as a seed planted. It's so simple even a child can do it.

#### Note: A seed does not care who plants it.

- It is not difficult to release healing to someone by faith. Realize God wants everyone to be healed more than you do.
  - ◆ Matthew 10:8, Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers; raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
  - ◆ Luke 9:2, And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.
  - ◆ **Acts 5:16,** There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which where vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.



### Jesus never took long to minister healing to people.

- Matthew 8:3, And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- ◆ Luke 22:51, And Jesus answered and said, suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.
- Sometimes when you take too long praying for people it can become unbelief. Remember, you are not trying to talk God into something that He has already provided.
- God hears you, not for your many words, but because of your faith-filled ones!
  - ◆ **Matthew 6:7b,** For they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.

Example: Jesus did not know who it was that touched Him when power flowed out of Him in Mark 5:30. His power flowed so quickly that He did not have time to turn around and see the woman with the issue of blood. It should not take a long time for God's power to flow out of you either. Learn to release the anointing and trust that it is going into the person creating a cure.

 Do not instruct the sick to confess sin before ministering to them.

If they have a sin they can deal with it afterwards.

Note: If the person does not see their healing manifest right away they may associate it with having some secret sin that they are unaware of. As a result it becomes very difficult to receive. It is better if sin is not an issue at all.

- It does not say in 1 Peter 2:24 that by His stripes and after confession of sin, you were healed.
- Realize that Jesus paid the price on His back for their healing before He paid the price for their sins on the cross. Anyone, sinner or believer, can receive healing; it is not conditional upon confession of sin. It's normal for a person to want to confess their sin if any, after receiving healing though.
  - ◆ James 5:15, And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Note: The prayer of faith for the sick was offered first, then forgiveness of sin.

# The Planting Of The Seed.

 When you minister to the sick, two things need to happen.

- **First,** remove the sickness. Consider how a gardener pulls the weeds before planting the seed. Likewise, use your authority to break the bondage, curse the root, and command the infirmity to go from the person.
- Second, impart the anointing. By faith, loose the power of God into the person using a point of contact such as laying on of hands.
  - ◆ Jeremiah 1:10, See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to <u>root out</u>, and to <u>pull down</u>, and <u>to destroy</u>, and to throw down, to <u>build</u>, and to <u>plant</u>.
  - ◆ Luke 13:12, And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and <u>said unto</u> her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. And he laid his hands on her; and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

Note: Sickness has been bound already in heaven and healing has already been loosed here on earth. Binding (addressing sickness or disease) is doing what has already been done in heaven and loosing (releasing the healing) is loosing what has already been loosed in heaven.

Another way of looking at it: Release the <u>fire</u> of the Holy Spirit first to burn out the problem and then release the <u>water</u> of the Holy Spirit to refresh and restore the person.

Example: I release the anointing to heal the sick by first having them put their hands out, but I do not touch their hands until I release the power. This is my point of contact but I don't hold on to their hands very long. Just a quick grab and I command sickness or disease to go. Then when I am ready to release faith for healing, I make a faith declaration that I am planting the healing seed and then I hold and release their hands again quickly. I also have them declare they have received the healing seed. In summary, the first part is binding the root and the second part is loosing the healing seed.

Summary: See healing as pulling the weed and then planting the good seed in its place.

- In Mark 8:22-25 Jesus laid his hands on a blind man twice. The first time he spit on his eyes and then put his hands upon him. The next time he did not spit, but He put his hands upon the man's eyes.
  - The first time Jesus asked the blind man what he saw. The man said he saw men, like trees walking. The Greek word for "saw" is "blepo" which means to look around. Then Jesus prayed again and put his hands on the man's eyes and told him to "look up" which is the Greek word "anablepo" which means to look again. This time the man was restored and saw everyone clearly.

Note: The Greek word "anablepo" is also used when Jesus fed the five thousand in Matthew 14:19. He looked once at the need then he looked up (anablepo; to look again) to heaven. This is what you do when praying for the sick. You look at the sickness and bind it, then look again at heaven's resources and sow the healing seed.

 Within every seed there is a full grown harvest packed inside.



- After you plant the seed by faith, from then on if you minister any more to them, just water the seed.
- John 4:14 explains that you have a well in you that can spring up to give others a drink. This is watering the seed!! Let the water bubble up and overflow to them.
- John 7:38 declares that he who believes in Jesus will have rivers of living water flowing out of him. Believe that when you lay hands on the sick in short, releasing sessions, that the water of the Holy Spirit is flowing out of you into them.

Note: It is important to release healing the way that works best for you. Do not make it complicated. Use the method that is right for you, but the key to releasing healing is faith. When I pray for the sick I am most comfortable with rooting out the sickness and then planting the healing seed. Smith Wigglesworth said that whatever method you believe will work, that method works the best for you.

Note: When planting the healing seed make a declaration of faith over the person. This is not a formula. Say what is in your heart. I like to say, "I release the life of God into you now, I plant healing, a healing seed." I have them say with their words that they receive the healing seed.

■ Instructing the person that they must receive the healing seed is important. The way to receive from God, whether it be salvation, healing, or an answer to prayer, is to believe in your heart and confess with your mouth (Romans 10:10). You must have both – belief in your heart and corresponding words from you own mouth. Example: "I receive my 100% healing seed. By Jesus' stripes I was healed!"

Note: If they don't want to speak up and declare that they received the healing seed, keep ministering to them anyway. Jesus did everything he could to help people receive. He never belittled the faith of those he ministered to. He never put the blame on them for not receiving. However, He did address the minister's lack of faith for not getting results.

◆ Mark 9:19, He answered him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him unto me.

## Manifestation of the Seed.

• After planting, growth to 100% is the focus.

Example; See the ones you have prayed for as 100% healed because of the 100% healing seed planted in them. From that point on you are only concerned with the growing and manifestation of the healing not the planting of it. You may have 20% or less of the seed manifested but you can rejoice knowing the rest is coming. It might be days later before they get the 100% manifested harvest.

It is always great to see the seed harvested immediately - a miracle. However, if a person leaves with symptoms they can be encouraged knowing they got their healing, but not the full manifestation. It may be during the night when it is fully manifested. What matters is that the seed was planted, it's growing and will mature soon.

■ There are some cases when seeds get a miracle grow and have a quick manifestation. Expect that but don't be discouraged if you don't see anything happening at that moment. A seed is in the ground and it will grow and bring forth fruit.

Example: I prayed for a lady in a tent who had loud popping in her shoulder joint and pain in her elbow. She had two problems, extreme pain and loud popping. When I ministered to her, the popping left but the pain did not. This was not discouraging because although she had a 50% manifestation of healing, she knew she was 100% healed because the seed was planted. The very next day she enjoyed the full manifestation; the pain left her elbow.

- Mark 4:20,22, And these are they, which are sown on good ground: such as hear the word, and receive it and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some hundred. For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested.
- ◆ Luke 17:14, And when Jesus saw the 10 lepers that he had ministered to, he said unto them, Go show yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.
- ◆ John 9:11, He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

Example: James 5:15-18 tells us how to pray for the sick as Elijah prayed. In 1 Kings 18:41-46 Elijah ends the 3 1/2 year drought by a faith declaration (he sowed the seed). He then sent his servant to check for the manifestation 6 times. After sending his servant the 7<sup>th</sup> time to check, he saw a cloud the size of a man's hand (the seed was manifesting but not fully). Elijah knew rain was coming and the sky became black with clouds and wind, and there was a heavy rain. Anytime you see a small manifestation of healing, get ready; you can expect to see the full manifestation!

- See every ministry session as interlocking building blocks, and everyone who prays for a sick person is building on the foundation (the seed).
  - You don't start at zero since the foundation has been laid. You should be adding blocks to complete the building (the healing).
  - Every person who ministers to a sick person who has already been prayed for, is building the manifestation of healing in him or her.
    - ◆ 1 Corinthians 3:9, For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry; ye are God's building.



- Healing is a recovery process. It takes time to manifest fully.
  - James 5:15 says that the Lord will raise them up.
  - 1 Peter 2:24 says that they shall recover.
    - ◆ Luke 10:33-34, But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, and went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him (a healing process).
    - ◆ James 5: 7-8a (Amplified), See how the farmer waits expectantly for the precious harvest from the land. See how he keeps up his patient vigil over it until it receives the early and late rains. So you also must be patient. Establish your hearts...

Example: If you are not seeing a manifestation in the people you pray for, you can miss it by not watering the seed and continually expecting the 100% harvest. I use my words and declare over all the people I have prayed for recently that they are manifesting the healing seed now.



- It is necessary for the person receiving the healing to act on what has been prayed.
  - James 2:17 says that faith without works is dead.
  - The key to acting is to take a step of faith. Sometimes the tendency is to get the person to do too much, too soon.

Example: You want the person to get out of the wheelchair but maybe the initial action could be the smallest thing that they could not do before being ministered to. Ask them to wiggle a paralyzed toe or finger. Then after gradually increasing steps of faith, the person will manifest healing more and more. You may have to instruct them to do more the next day for when they are back home.

It is not a lack of faith to take a small step of faith!

Example: When I was in Cuba I prayed for a lady who was paralyzed on half her body from a stroke months earlier. After ministering to her before I left, I told her to do small actions in faith every day as she believed God for 100% manifested healing. Later I was told that she asked her husband to bring a broom and she swept on one side of her bed while lying in it. Next thing, she was able to "sweep" on both sides of the bed. Eventually she sat up and could sweep from that position. Finally she was able to get out of bed, stand and sweep her room. Ultimately she was sweeping her whole house. Now (several months later) her healing is completely manifested and she is the janitor of the church in Cuba.

- ◆ James 2:17 (Amplified), So also faith, if it does not have works (deeds and actions of obedience to back it up), by itself is destitute of power (inoperative, dead).
- Mark 4 gives insight about how the Kingdom of God operates as a farmer sowing seed. Sowing seed is only the first step, there are more faith steps involved in a person's healing harvest. Don't have them run in faith when they should start walking first, and then add actions to their faith every day.

Example: I have pulled a couple of people out of wheelchairs to make them walk around the room only to set them back in the wheelchair. It was too big of a first step and left them more discouraged then before.



Obedience will bring healing manifestations.

As a minister, God may have you do something in obedience to help the manifestation.

Example: Jesus rubbed clay in blind eyes, He told another person to go and wash, He put people out of a room, He spit on dirt and applied it to a person's eyes, He told a man to take up his bed and walk etc...

Example: When praying for a man's eyesight, I put spit on my finger and rubbed it in his eyes. That was years ago, and to this day he still doesn't need glasses anymore.

■ The Lord may also have the person you minister to, do something in faith.

Example: You may pray for someone with an ulcer and the Lord impresses him or her to go eat spicy food.

- Sometimes people can delay or stop manifestations by not obeying instructions by the Holy Spirit.
- God may lead you at times to give specific instructions to convey to the sick to bring their manifestation.

Note: What would have happened if the blind man (John 9) who Jesus told to go and wash in the pool of Siloam, went to a different pool?

Example: I prayed for a Hungarian man who was diagnosed with a tumor in his lung. He was going to have surgery in the next two days. I felt impressed by the Lord to tell him if he felt something change to have another x-ray made before proceeding with surgery. That night he said he felt a big pop in his chest and then a warm feeling inside. He did not have another x-ray like I told him, went ahead with surgery and they found a small infection.

Example: A lady came to our house in Romania that had just undergone extensive testing for suspected cancer. We prayed for her and I felt impressed by the Lord to tell her the cancer was gone. I also told her that her previous tests would come back that she had cancer, but to have new ones made since we prayed for her after the first tests were made. Sure enough, the tests confirmed she had cancer but she did not get discouraged. She had them test her again and the new results proved there was no cancer.

Note: Be certain of what God is telling you for the person you are ministering to before you tell them. Faith to act comes by hearing God. See Romans 10:17.

Example: I prayed for another lady who had cancer and was not expected to live long. I felt impressed by God to tell her to listen to some preaching recordings about healing over and over again each day. If she would do that I knew she would live and not die and I told her so. When she died a few weeks later I found out from her family that she never listened to them.

## Miracles Are Not Healing Seeds.

- Receiving a miracle or gift of healing is like receiving a houseplant instead of a packet of seeds; you enjoy the benefits immediately.
  - A healing seed has to be planted, watered and eventually it grows into a manifested healing.
    - ◆ 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, For one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom, to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another gifts of healing by the same Spirit. To another the working of miracles...
  - Miracles and gifts of healings are part of the gifts of the Spirit.
  - Gifts of healing are an instant cure (example: a healed liver) and working of miracles is a creative cure (example: a new liver).
  - God's grace in the form of miracles and gifts of healings is available for extreme situations that time does not allow for a healing seed to grow.
  - He initiates these, whereas sowing a healing seed is something any believer can initiate at any time.
  - When you have a great need or emergency, you can ask God for a miracle.

- John 2:1-10 describes a marriage feast and the first miracle Jesus performed. There are some keys revealed in these verses that show how the first miracle Jesus did was activated.
  - Need/Verse 3 There must be a great desire and need. They
    were out of wine at the wedding celebration and desperate
    for more.
  - Persistence/Verse 4, The timing may not be convenient.
     Persistence is required. Jesus had other things on His mind but His mother refused to let go of this miracle.
  - Obedience/Verse 5, Obey no matter what. Jesus' mother knew that obedience to His words always brought the desired results.
  - o <u>Fullness/Verses 7</u>, Go all out, not half way. Miracles come from full obedience. The servants filled the water pots to the brim. You fill yourself with God's Word. When fullness comes then suddenly happens (Acts 2:1,2, Acts 6:8, Galatians 4:4).
  - Risk/Verse 8 Draw out into the glass now and take it to the master. It would not have required much faith to wait till later to draw out the wine and then serve it to the unknown guy in the back. Obedience requires trust.
  - Serve Others/Verse 8, Motivated to serve others. The purpose for the miracle at the wedding feast was so that everyone could partake. Philippians 2:3-5 tells us to consider others, being of the same mind as Christ. Helping someone get their miracle, helps you get yours.



Conclusion: It's not hard to get healed or minister healing to others. Yes, there are special times that miracles and gifts of healing are needed but that doesn't have to be the norm. If you keep planting and watering, healing will come. If you have been standing for a healing for a very long time, it's time to plant a new healing seed and get your long overdue healing. A farmer doesn't quit planting just because he had a crop failure; instead he goes back to the ground and sows again. Start sowing healing in your life and the lives of others. Jesus is the Lord of the harvest and says the harvest is great but not many want to be laborers, will you be one? Multitudes of people in every place need the Kingdom of God to come near to them. To a hurting person, there is no greater expression of God's love than His healing power. Become a co-laborer with God, doing the works of Jesus in this great end-time harvest adventure!

Luke 10:2,8, Therefore he said unto them, the harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; pray ye therefore the LORD OF THE HARVEST, that he would sent forth laborers into his harvest. Verse 8; and into whatsoever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you and heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
