Seven people are helping now, including a guitar player. The kids really enjoy redeeming their points at the Rewards Store. "Recently we started a series of lessons of everyone in the Bible that Jesus healed" said Flavia.

"We taught about Jesus healing the two blind men in Matthew 20:29. We played games and made a craft in which they glued eyes on a drawing and colored it. We sang songs that the kids love including, "You are the God That Heals Me."

This Saturday we taught on Jesus Healing an Official's daughter in Mark 5:21.
